INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

ACCEPTANCE: Individuals listed in Enclosure 1 have been accepted for participation in the Irradiator Technology (H-315) course. This course is scheduled to be presented April 14-17, 2026 at the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Region IV Offices. The NRC Region IV Office is located at 1600 East Lamar Blvd., Room 1062, Arlington, Texas 76011. The facility's telephone number is (817) 200-1100.

COURSE: Please note that the course begins at 9:00 a.m. central time on Tuesday, April 14th and ends at 12:00 p.m. central time on Friday, April 17th.

LODGING AND TRAVEL: Please plan to arrive on Monday, April 13th, and depart on Friday, April 17th. Please plan to attend the course throughout the stated end time of 12:00 p.m. If there are no flights available that would allow you to arrive home before midnight on Friday, you may elect to depart early on Saturday, April 18th. In this event, NRC will provide reimbursement for hotel on Friday night and per diem on Saturday. Students need to make their lodging and air travel arrangements through El Sol Travel at (844) 244-6694 and indicate that the travel is "Invitational" for the NRC. Please select a fully refundable government fare, El Sol Travel will direct bill the NRC for the flight. Traveler is responsible for providing a personal credit card to El Sol to reserve the hotel at the federal rate or lower, hotels are not direct billed to NRC. If the need arises and you must make a change and/or cancel, contact Karen Meyer at (301) 465-0791 at least 2 weeks prior to the course.

Please complete the Travel Application Form which will be provided to you and submit to AStrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov, at your earliest opportunity, but **no later** than, Friday, April 3rd. The per diem for Arlington, Texas is \$181 for hotel and \$80 for meals and incidentals. The first and last day of travel is calculated at 75 percent (\$60). Students are responsible for their own transportation (taxi/uber/subway, etc.) between the hotel and the training center. If you are authorized to drive your personal vehicle, the Federal mileage reimbursement is 73 cents per mile.

- Hotel **must** be reserved with ElSol.
- State vehicles are **not** authorized for mileage reimbursement. Hotel parking is reimbursable.
- Rental cars are **not** authorized for reimbursement.
- Airport parking is allowed for personal and State vehicles; however, will only be reimbursed up to the standard rate (i.e., no valet parking).
- Must provide ALL receipts for items over \$75. You need to list individual taxi/uber/lyft as separate items – **NO** lump total.
- Travel is allowed the day before and day after if you will not arrive home by midnight on the last day of class.
- For personal vehicles, you will need to include a map showing the mileage to and from.
- No personal time is allowed to be added before/after official NRC travel.

In addition, you will need to complete the attached NRC-64 voucher for reimbursement upon return from travel, **no later** than, Friday, April 24th. Review the itemized list for accuracy, including hotel, hotel tax and any additional authorized expenses. Additional expenses that were not included may be denied on a case-by-case basis. Sign the NRC-64 and e-mail back to

Astrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov with your hotel (individual days & a zero balance), taxi/uber (**tip not to exceed 15%**), flight receipt, and all other receipts including meals.
